Ayla the Aboyne Lodge Dog





<u>Rules</u>

Ayla is now very settled at Aboyne Lodge. However, she is still a young dog and needs everyone to follow these rules to ensure she stays happy and calm.

- 1. Only Approach Ayla if she is wearing her 'On Duty!' coat.
- 2. Always ask the adult with her if you can stroke or touch her.
- 3. Do not run up to her. (People running towards her may scare her or over excite her)
- 4. Do not crowd round her. If there are three people with her keep back. The adult will tell you when you can approach her.
- 5. Do not shout or call her name as she walks around the school. (If everyone calls her name it will scare her and it will disturb your lessons)
- 6. If she runs towards you or jumps up at you just **ignore her**. **Keep your hands to yourself**. (This will help her learn not to do this. We do not want her to encourage her to jump up.)
- 7. Do not tease her by waving hands or objects at her face.
- 8. If you walk past the office and she is on her own **do not put your hands through the gate to stroke her**. If there is an adult there ask before you stroke her.
- 9. Sometimes Ayla may be tired need some peace and quiet so always listen to the adult with her and follow their instructions.
