MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD

Dear Parents/Carers,

It only seems like yesterday that we were moving back into our newly refurbished building, but the Christmas holidays are finally here.

We were treated this week to a wonderful Nativity from the Reception and Nursery children. It always amazes me how confident the children are and they all spoke and sang beautifully. Congratulations to all of the children on a great show and thank you to all the staff team for putting it all together.

On Thursday, we had our first whole school trip to the pantomime at Harpenden. It was really good to see the children having a fantastic time watching the show. It is these moments that children will remember when they get older as they look back on their time at Aboyne.

The school is following the news about Covid and checking the guidance from Government closely . There is one change that has just come in: all adults who are fully vaccinated and children aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 — whether Omicron or not—should take a lateral flow device (LFD)

test every day for 7 days instead of selfisolating. Contact tracing, will be completed by NHS Test and Trace and not by the school.
